***Notes:**

- **Delegates who speak at the voting AND the signing:** Samuel Adams, Josiah Bartlett, William Ellery, Benjamin Franklin, John Hancock, Stephen Hopkins
- **John Hancock** is President of Congress and calls the Congress to order (or to begin.)
- **Benjamin Harrison** has lines at different points as the Chairman of the Committee including saying "The declaration has passed with unanimous consent!" once all colonies vote.
- **Robert Treat Paine** is the "Objection Maker," who says "I object!" anytime someone asks for an objection.
- **Thomas McKean** questions Caesar Rodney's whereabouts after he votes
- **Caesar Rodney** is late and needs to act "tired"

Errors:

- For delegates that only speak during the voting, some of their lines are listed under a heading that says "At the Signing" when it should say "Final Voting"
- John Penn is listed as representing Pennsylvania, when it should be North Carolina
